

Call for Nominations for Election to the Grafton Residents Association Committee 2023

The Grafton Residents Association Committee is responsible for the Association's strategic direction and management.

The purpose of the Association is to promote and protect the interests and welfare of the citizens of Grafton, foster community engagement, make submissions to appropriate authorities on any matters affecting the wellbeing of Grafton, represent the interests of parties within the Grafton area before Auckland Council, the Waitemata Local Board and other authorities, and enhance and promote the natural and physical heritage, history, amenity and attractiveness of the Grafton area.

Nominations shall close at 5pm on the fifth day before the Annual General Meeting. All retiring members of the Committee shall be eligible for re-election.
